



Sea kayak on Mooloolaba Bay

Sunday 31st October 2010, from 1pm till about 4.30pm.

If you'd like to get out on the water while you're on the Sunshine Coast, here's a perfect opportunity! Join us on a Sea Kayaking tour on Mooloolaba Bay. Paddle the calm, clear waters to Point Cartwright and across to Alexandra Headland. The coastal headlands and mangrove environments set the scene for superb wildlife viewing - turtles, pods of dolphins, fish, eagles and shore birds. This trip is ideal for anyone who needs a little time out to relax, and no kayaking experience is necessary. You do need to be confident around water and your guides will provide full tuition before departure. This activity is being organised with Aussie Sea Kayaking Company (www.ausseakayak.com.au), a company with 10 years experience operating sea kayaking tours around the world. The trip is weather dependent and trip itinerary may change, but even if there is a little wind around on the day, we should still be able to get out on the bay.

Getting there: If you need transport to the starting point (at the Sunshine Coast Sea Kayak Centre, Mooloolaba) from the resort (and back again), a group taxi will be organised (and a share of the taxi cost will be extra to the trip fee). Departure time from the resort will be 12:30pm.
